



Planning your journey to the IMM 2025

IMM Location:

Loughton Showground, East Sussex, England, UK. BN8 6BN

Traveling from Europe:

Local ferry ports are:

Newhaven, there are currently 2 crossings a day from Dieppe, France. Newhaven port is 24 miles / 39 Km from the IMM.

Dover, there are multiple carriers and numerous crossings each day from Calais and some from Dunkirk. Dover port is around 75 miles / 120 km from the IMM. Your route planner will probably try and offer you a route via the motorway, the distance is very similar on the smaller roads and great to start seeing some English towns, villages, and countryside.

If you're looking to travel via public transport.

Gatwick Airport has many flights a day from many European airports. Gatwick is 42 miles / 68Km by road.

Trains from Gatwick to the IMM There is one train an hour that will take you from Gatwick to Lewes directly in 32 minutes, with several others that require one change on route. You should however note the last direct train on a weekday is 22.52 and they don't operate a direct service at weekends, so you would need to change at Brighton. Once you arrive in Lewes, you're 7.6 miles / 15 Km from the IMM.

There will be many hire car options from Gatwick and local Taxis from Lewes Station.

Eurostar also terminates in central London.

Trains from Central London to the IMM There is one train an hour that will take you from London's Victoria Station to Lewes directly in 63 minutes, with several others that require one change on route. You should however note the last direct train on a weekday is 21.00 and they don't operate a direct service at weekends, so you would need to change at Brighton. Once you arrive in Lewes, you're 7.6 miles / 15 Km from the IMM.

Completing your journey to the IMM by **Bus**.

There is a regular bus service from Brighton to Loughton Village (Number 28 Regency Route) it takes around 1 hour 20 minutes and calls at Lewes and Ringmer on route.

Traveling from the UK via public transport.

Trains from Central London to the IMM There is one train an hour that will take you from London's Victoria Station to Lewes directly in 63 minutes, with several others that require one change on route. You should however note the last direct train on a weekday is 21.00 and they don't operate a direct service at weekends, so you would need to change at Brighton. Once you arrive in Lewes, you're 7.6 miles / 15 Km from the IMM.

Bus There is a regular bus service from Brighton to Loughton Village (Number 28 Regency Route) it takes around 1 hour 20 minutes and calls at Lewes and Ringmer on route.
